I LOVE SASQUATCH CHILI Tables and chairs will be provided. Supply your own utensils and camp stove. Bring your uncooked ingredients for preparation on site. This is a "no holds barred" chili competition (Amateur) from roadkill to rattlesnake, all kinds of chili are encouraged. Red or green, with beans or without, hot, medium, or mild – you decide. An umbrella or shade tent may also be useful.

Entrants will cook 2 quarts of chili. Cooks will set up at 10 AM and start cooking as soon as they are ready and have been given the "GO" signal by a chili official. Judging and public tasting will begin at 1 PM. Prizes will be awarded at 2 PM. (All times approximate)

Taste tickets will be sold to the public; proceeds to benefit the Carson City Sesquicentennial, or 150th Birthday. Entry fee \$20.

OFFICIAL "SASQUATCH" CHILI COOK-OFF RULES

- 1. Each entry will be assigned a <u>Contestant Number</u> by a Cook-Off Official before cooking begins. Each booth will be given tasting cups, plastic spoons, and napkins for the public tasting, which begins at 1 PM. Each booth will also get a can to collect the taste tickets.
- 2. At the time you set up your booth, please give the names of all cooks to the Cook-Off Official. No other persons are allowed to participate in the cooking, assist, or give advice during preparation or cooking.
- 3. You may begin cooking **after** your ingredients are inspected by an Official, as soon as you can.
- 4. Each entry will prepare a **2 quart minimum** of chili. *No ingredients may be pre-cooked*. Ingredients may be peeled, chopped, sliced, diced, or cut-up before hand. Final ingredient preparation may be done on-site.

NO MIXES - RECIPES MUST BE ORIGINAL!

- 5. At 1 PM an Official will collect a judging sample. The judges will taste and cast their ballots.
- 6. **Public tasting will begin at 1 PM**, after judging samples have been collected from <u>all</u> entries.

PLEASE COLLECT TASTE TICKETS **BEFORE** SERVING THE CHILI.

1 TICKET = 1 SERVING.

7. You may pack up when you are out of chili.



- 8. Following the judging, at around 2:30 PM, winners will be announced.
- 9. Then relax and enjoy the party!
